



BCRCHA Class Rules

OPEN:

Open to all horses, regardless of breed or ownership, owners & riders must be in good standing with the BCRCHA. (Default to NCHA rules)

NON-PRO:

Open to any Non Professional rider who has not shown, trained or assisted in training horses for remunerations, directly or indirectly, or has not been paid to work in any manner (astride) in the above activity on the premises of a horse training operation. A Non-Pro may ride his/her own horse or a horse owned by a member of his/her immediate family. One horse per rider per show. (Default to NCHA rules)

\$10,000 NOVICE HORSE:

Open to any rider, to be ridden one (1) handed. Horse cannot have earned more than \$10,000 in approved NCHA, CCHA, BCCHA, ICHA, BCRCHA or any recognized cutting horse organization as of January 01 of the current year.

\$3,000 NOVICE HORSE:

Same as above, with the exception of earnings not to exceed \$3,000.

\$2,000 RIDER:

Open to any rider whose lifetime earnings in the above associations does not exceed \$2,000 as of January 01 of the current year. Horse to be ridden one (1) handed. Rider may ride only one horse per show. Note: Rider is permitted to show a horse that he/she does not own.

\$750 PROGRESSIVE HORSE:

Open to any rider, to be ridden one (1) handed. Horse can be stopped on the ends. Horse cannot have earned in excess of \$750 as of January 01 of the current year in the above associations.

\$500 LIMITED RIDER:

Open to any rider that has not won in excess of \$500 in above listed associations as of January 01 of the current year. This class is to be ridden one (1) handed. Horse can be stopped on the ends. One horse per rider per show.

\$500 RANCH HORSE:

Open to any horse that has not won in excess of \$500 in the above listed associations as of January 01 of the current year and can be ridden by any rider and can be shown either one (1) or two (2) handed. Horse to be shown in any NCHA approved bit or hackamore. Note: Rider cannot change from one (1) to two (2) hands (or vice versa) once horse has crossed the time line.

NOVICE/NOVICE:

Open to any horse that has not won in excess of \$500 in the above listed associations as of January 01 of the current year. To be ridden two (2) handed by a rider who has not won in excess of \$100 in the above listed associations as of January 01 of the current year. Horse can be shown in any humane bit (final discretion to be given to judge and BCRCHA board of directors) , no training devices.

YOUTH:

Open to any youth who has not reached their 18th birthday as of January 01 of the current year. Youth riders will compete for points, not monies. Rider may ride any horse using reasonable equipment, and may ride one (1) or two (2) handed. Use of helmets is mandatory.

NOTE: ALL YOUTH RIDERS MUST WEAR A HELMET WHEN RIDING AT BCRCHA APPROVED EVENTS.
